



### Winterizing Tips

After the camp closes we will be winterizing the park and your unit. It is necessary for us to have complete access to your home so please check with the office to make sure we have a full set of keys for your unit, including the Florida Room. If you have your hot water access door inside your porch area, please leave it accessible. This same thing applies to a washing machine, please keep it accessible and leave power to the machine on so we can run the pump.

Here are some suggestions for packing up your home for the winter:

1. Inside your home, turn off the breaker for the hot water heater and the main breaker, please leave all the other breakers on. We will turn off power at the outside post when we are done winterizing.
2. Turn off your water at the outside post.
3. Empty your fridge and freezer and leave the door propped open
4. Empty all food from your cabinets
5. Remove all liquids including cleaners, soaps, shampoo, etc. Anything liquid will freeze and any food items will attract animals, so if there are things you want to leave in your home over the winter then place them in a plastic bin or container.

If you have any questions please feel free to come up to the office.

If you have any cans of food you are getting rid of at the end of the season please drop them at the office. We will donate them to the local food pantry.
